Environmental Occupational Training Services

MCS occupational safety and health training services provides our clients' employees with practical knowledge and hands-on training. We protect the personnel by teaching them how to recognize unsafe work conditions, how to prevent workplace illness and accidents, and how their actions can affect workplace safety. We provide courses which are standard (off-the-shelf), customized, and computer-based interactive. Training may be conducted on or off site and may be on any number of environmentally-related issues, including fire preparedness training and public fire safety education. The following is a portion of our classes:

- HAZMAT - 24-hour, 40-hour operations, 8-hour supervisors, and 8-hour refresher.
- Lead Awareness - 8-hour and 40-hour lead awareness.
- Asbestos Training - 40-hour for contractors/supervisors (EPA-approved), 32-hour worker, and 8-hour refresher.
- Safety Areas - respiratory protection, forklift, fall protection, and confined spaces.
- First Aid/CPR using the Medic First Aid Training Course.

Projects

Libby Montana Superfund Site, 40-hour Contractor/Supervisor Asbestos Training

W.R. Grace operated a vermiculite mine from 1963 until 1990 in the small town of Libby located in the northwest corner of Montana. The vermiculite ore mined in Libby was contaminated with tremolite asbestos. MCS provided training for the contractor employees cleaning Libby residences contaminated with vermiculite insulation and asbestos. We've trained over 55 persons in the last two years as Contractor/Supervisors and we've conducted three 80-hour refresher courses in Libby.

HAZMAT Training, Corixa Corporation

Corixa is a cancer research and development corporation. They required HAZMAT training for the large amount of hazardous materials held on site, mainly formaldehyde and acetone. MCS conducted a 24-hour Hazardous Materials Technician course for 12 staff members.
